

## State Income Tax Withholding Election Notice for Qualified Pension and Annuity Payments

**Instructions:** Find your state of residence and complete the form as directed. If you do not return this form, your state's default election must be applied, which may or may not result in an amount withheld. If you make an election, you must sign and complete the Personal Information section.

<b>California residents:</b> If you do not return this form, and Federal income tax is withheld, California state income tax withholding will be equal to 10% of the amount of federal income tax withheld, <b>or</b> please select one of the following options:

2. I want my state income tax withholding from each periodic pension or annuity payment to be figured using the number of allowances and marital status shown.
